This program is 10 weeks and will run from June 20th through August 22nd.

Required hours are every Saturday 9:00-2:30 at the market and additional check-in meetings with the Manager as needed. The rest of the work is done on your own schedule.

- Stipend: \$1,000

Managing the Kids Club Program involves setting up/tearing down the booth, setting up activities, distributing Kids Bucks, record keeping, planning different activities and engagements for the kids, marketing, and general program management.

Other tasks include boosting overall marketing efforts and working with the BIFMA board.

Check-ins with the Manager would include a market reflection, planning tasks for the upcoming week, checking in on ongoing tasks and discussing new ideas/strategies.
